



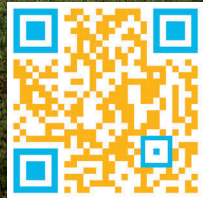
HARVEST WATER: RELIABLE RECYCLED WATER FOR REGIONAL SUSTAINABILITY

Harvest Water, SacSewer's landmark recycled water project, broke ground in 2024 and is anticipated to be operational in 2027. This innovative project will be one of California's most extensive water recycling programs, transforming how our region reuses water.

Once complete, Harvest Water will deliver regional environmental benefits that will facilitate groundwater recovery, boost sustainable agriculture, strengthen local habitats, and offer near-term benefits to the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta.

SacSewer offers residential and commercial customers the opportunity to fill containers with free recycled water at the Recycled Water Fill Station located at the EchoWater Resource Recovery Facility near Elk Grove. This environmentally responsible and safe recycled water can be used for watering lawns, gardens, and landscaping, as well as for dust control or other permitted uses.



Users must be in SacSewer's service area and must complete an application and a short training session to obtain a permit for the use of the recycled water.
