Household Hazardous Waste Facilities will accept mercury-containing items, such as compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) and silver mercury thermometers. Proper disposal helps protect our waterways and environment. Many retailers will now accept CFLs. Ask about it at your local home improvement center.
